# Collegium Musicum Populare, Cologne

In June 2016, the second edition of the "Collegium Musicum Populare"-Workshop took place at the University of Cologne, Germany. The workshop aims at supporting young popular music scholars by providing a cooperative and helpful atmosphere to discuss their current research projects, ideas and future plans. Attendants can be any IASPM D-A-CH-member, no matter which career stage. The workshop in Cologne featured seven presentations ranging from PhD-projects to a habilitation outline. Further, Federico Spinetti screened his documentary "The Enemy" about the recuperation of anti-fascist partisan songs by Italian punk musicians.



During the conference in Graz, IASPM D-A-CH awarded the newly installed Maria-Hanáček-Award. In memory of our dear colleague and founding member of IASPM D-A-CH who passed away in 2013, the award honors the best paper presentation given by PhD candidates during the biennial IASPM D-A-CH conferences. In 2016, Lena Jade Müller (Berlin, Germany) won the award for her outstanding presentation "White Desire in the Appropriation of Black Music" ("Weißes Begehren in der Aneignung schwarzer Musik").
